

Missionaries and ministries focused on Muslim Evangelism gathered in Durbanville for a Prayer Forum to discuss and pray over a comprehensive Christian Response to the violent upheavals in the Middle East and escalating Islamic terrorism. Missions throughout the Middle East have suffered enormous disruptions as literally millions of indigenous Christians have fled from the Middle East since the explosion of the Arab Spring in 2011. The destruction of hundreds of churches throughout Syria, Iraq and Egypt have been particularly devastating. The loss of millions of indigenous Christians who spoke the local languages, from the Middle East mission fields, represents one of the most catastrophic reversals in church history.

Understand Islam – Evangelise Muslims

The organiser of the Prayer Forum expressed appreciation for our [**Slavery, Terrorism and Islam – The Historic Roots and Contemporary Threat**](#) book, and emphasized its importance for anyone interested in Muslim Evangelism to study. I emphasized the importance of praying the Psalms, personal one-on-one Evangelism with Muslims, particularly emphasizing the parables of Christ, using social media, and the internet, to reach Muslims. In restricted access areas, stealth technology such as the Bible and Christian films and Discipleship materials on SD cards can be used on mobile electronic devices. It is essential that we support, encourage and serve Christians who are in the Middle East, enabling them to survive and thrive in the face of such relentless opposition.
